Families can choose between a half-day or all-day program.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Student must be potty trained in order to be eligible for enrollment.
- For the 3 year-old program, the student must be 3 by 8/1/2022 in order to be eligible to enroll.
- For the 4 year-old program, the student must be 4 by 8/1/2022 in order to be eligible to enroll.

BEFORE & AFTER CARE PROGRAM

Our extended care program includes two offerings before-care and after-care. Our hours are operations are 7:15AM to 7:55AM for before-care and then 3:30-6:00PM for after-care.

Our 2021-2022 rates are as follows:

Full Time Before-Care: \$100/month Full Time After-Care: \$250/month Part-Time Before-Care: \$10/visit Part-Time After-Care: \$25/visit

Full Time Before & After Care: \$340/month

STANDARDIZED DRESS CODE

BIBLICAL INTEGRATION

LCA provides an environment of learning centered in a Biblical Worldview, dependent on a high-level quality curriculum, administered by caring, well-equipped, Christian educators.

We intentionally examine all subject areas through the lens of the Bible.

Our educators equip students by addressing the Biblical purpose for studying the topic, connecting and comparing assumptions in their fields of study, and evaluating worldview questions in their content area. Students come to the realization that God is present in all facets of life, and that Scripture is our ultimate source of truth.



WEEKLY CHAPEL

Led by the Spiritual Life Director, chapel is designed to encourage and equip students to grow stronger in their faith as they prepare for college. Chapel is comprised of praise & worship plus a lesson.

CURRICULUM

LCA's preschool curriculum is both developmentally appropriate and academically challenging. It is well planned and comprehensive. The curriculum effectively teaches social, emotional, cognitive, physical, and spiritual skills.

The school day consists of a balance of large group, small group, and one-on-one instruction. In addition, it include includes movement, creative expression, social interaction, and problem solving.

PURPOSEFUL PLAY

Excellent programs are academically challenging while also being developmentally appropriate and purposeful.

This premise comes from scripture in Luke 2:52, "And Jesus grew in wisdom, and stature, and in favor with God and man." God gave Jesus the time to grow and develop before sending Him to His ministry. We, too, must provide our children with time to develop and it cannot be rushed nor left to chance

LCA's preschool program employs purposeful learning, which is meaningful to children between the ages of three and five. It is through developmentally appropriate experiences that children begin to make connections, which grow them into life-long learners.

At LCA, we understand the unique make-up of children and focus on what children do best --play. Play is a child's best work! Play experiences capture a child's interest, engage him/her in the learning process, and encourage the appropriate development essential for a three to five year-old.

Our teachers thoughtfully design and organize their classrooms into learning centers, which assist with the intentional instruction of skills.

In addition, the school day includes opportunities for physical activity either at the playground or in the gymnasium.

ADMISSIONS PROCESS

The admissions process is designed to ensure a student's readiness and academic placement so that he or she might have a rewarding experience at LCA. We also desire to confirm compatibility in Christian values, philosophy, and essential beliefs between parents and the school so that a strong partnership is forged between the Christian home and the school. Our admissions criteria reflects our commitment to serve as a partner with the home and the local church in the Christian education of our students.



STEP 1: APPLY ONLINE

To begin the online visit the school's website, go to ADMISSIONS, select ADMISSIONS PROCESS, and then choose SUBMIT.

- Create an online application account.
- Provide information regarding the student's academic history, behavioral history, as well as the names and email addresses of a church leader and current teacher for the student's recommendation forms.
- If your student has an IEP or 504 plan, contact the Admissions Office for additional guidance regarding the school's intervention services.
- The online application includes a \$50 fee.

STEP 3: PARTICIPATE IN FAMILY INTERVIEW

The interview will be scheduled once the school has received the student's application and supporting documentation.

- The meeting will include the principal, Admissions Director, student and his/her parents.
- The interview provides the family the opportunity to learn more about the school and the student's schedule. It also provides the school with the opportunity to learn more about the student's academic history, interests, and the family's spiritual life.

STEP 2: PROVIDE RECORDS

Families can submit copies of the following records to the Admissions Office:

- Birth Certificate
- KY Immunization Record
- KY Physical Exam Record
- KY Eye Exam
- KY Dental Exam

STEP 4: ENROLL ONLINE

Upon acceptance, the family is invited to enroll if a space is available.

- If space is not available, the student will be placed on a wait list until a spot opens up.
- To finalize the student's enrollment, families will complete an online agreement and submit an enrollment fee.
- Once the online enrollment agreement is complete and the enrollment fee is paid, the student is an official LCA student and is eligible to finalize his/her schedule.
