SPECIALS TEAM HIGHLIGHT

In this week's faculty spotlight, we are learning about our Spanish classes.

PRESCHOOL SPANISH: The Preschoolers are continuing to finish learning the 4 basic colors that match their table assignments - **Rojo, Azul, Verde, & Amarillo**. During the next two weeks they'll finish with **Azul**. Most have mastered **Rojo, Verde, & Amarillo** very well! During November, we'll learn how to say "Thank You" (Gracias) and "You're Welcome" (de nada) as we focus on grateful hearts during the Thanksgiving Season!

TK SPANISH: The TK-ers have completed learning their 3 primary colors plus green - **Rojo, Azul, Verde, & Amarillo**. Over the next several weeks, we'll continue to add to our vocabulary bank as we enter the season of Thanksgiving and on being grateful, learning "Thank You" (Gracias) and "You're Welcome" (de nada). In addition, we will begin to work on our Numbers 1-10 (uno, dos, tres, cuatro, cinco, seis, siete, ocho, nueve, & diez).

K-5TH SPANISH: We celebrated Hispanic Heritage Month by taking a look at the 21 different Spanish-speaking countries around the world and their different cultures. We took a virtual field trip to explore God's beautiful creation in various Spanish-speaking countries. This study helps us gain knowledge and understanding of other cultures and meets the Kentucky World Language Standards.



Our preschool classes were treated to a special guest from the fire department. They learned important safety tips including "stop, drop, and roll." We are thankful for our community helpers!
