CHAPEL CHAT

As we learned about the RAINBOW, I challenged them to remember 2 things:

- Since it takes water and LIGHT to make a rainbow, every time they see a RAINBOW, I want them to remember that God wants them to be like Noah - follow and obey God - and be a LIGHT to the people around them.
- Every time they see a RAINBOW, I want them to remember how much God LOVES them.

AT HOME APPLICATION ♥

1. Ask and see if they remember these 2 things.
2. Ask them how they think they can be a LIGHT for God.
3. The next time you see a RAINBOW and you are with your child - remind them of the 2 key things they are to remember and discuss them.

BIBLE VISITS

During my Bible Visits to each class, we focus on the CHARACTER TRAIT that accompanies the Unit. With each Character Trait they'll learn a "Buzzphrase" to help them remember how God wants them to live. Our last one in September was *Generosity*, and during October we'll cover *Perseverance & Humility*.

Starburst Generosity

During our *Generosity* Bible Visit, we talked about the story Jesus told of the poor widow who gave all she had at the Temple. I gave the kids a *Starburst Challenge*. They had 3 options that they could choose to do with their 2-pack of Starbursts: 1.) Eat both themselves. 2.) Eat 1 and cheerfully give the other to someone else. 3.) Cheerfully give both to someone else. Ask your child what they chose and why; this is a great opportunity to talk with them about being *generous*, cheerful givers!
